### **Interview Preparation**

- practice answers beforehand
  - write out questions on index cards & summarize answers on back
  - DO NOT MEMORIZE answers, but know what you want to say

### **How to Dress**

- professional outfit
- men: suit & tie
- women: pants/skirt suit or dress with jacket
- avoid a lot of makeup, accessories, perfume, etc.
- no bright colors, keep it simple (don't be remembered by your outfit)
- comfortable shoes/another pair

# **Interview Types**

- one on one
- group interview
- MMI
- panel
- mock PBL/SGL
- open/closed file

# **Interview Day**

- BE ON TIME!!
- interviews (obviously)
- tour of the school/clinic
- Q & A with current students
- financial aid presentation
- food (yay!)
- school curriculum presentation

### Interviews!

- The best answers involve...
  - answering the question that was asked
  - giving specific examples
  - relating to the ultimate purpose at hand (i.e. dental school)

### **Tell Me About Yourself**

- do not tell your life story
- think about 3 main topics to discuss
- this is not just a casual question, treat is seriously

# What are your strengths?

- be specific
- think of how others would describe you
- make sure you give relevant skills/qualities

# What are your weaknesses?

- do not use actual positives as weaknesses (i.e. perfectionist)
- think about actual weakness & how you are working to improve them
- tell the truth

# Why do you want to go into this field?

- how you made your decision
- why does dentistry attract you
- do not repeat yourself

# Why our school?

- do research beforehand
- website, talking to current students, visiting, etc.

### **Context Questions**

- questions that arise from previous answers
- make it interesting
- don't give one-word answers

### **Case Questions**

- typically "What would you do if...?"
  - can't practice specific answers beforehand
- don't panic!
  - ok to say "Let me think for a minute"
  - answer in stages
  - think aloud
  - ask further clarification

### **Ask Questions!**

- do not ask questions that can be answered through the website (i.e. tuition)
- have several questions in mind that you want to ask

# Keep in mind...

- your tone (volume, pace, inflection)
- body language
  - posture
  - hands

### **Common Themes**

- diversity
- leadership
- why this school (make sure you do research ahead of time)
- ethics
- personal characteristics
- volunteering

### **After the Interview**

- send thank you notes to EVERYONE who interviewed you
- write down as much as you can remember after the interview (what you thought went well, poorly, questions that were asked, etc.)
  - this will help you improve future interviews
